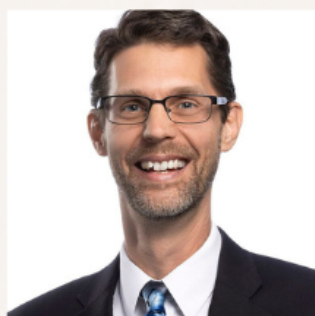
This volume represents a landmark attempt to explore how Chinese Christians understand and participate in mission. It offers new missiological insights about identity, creativity, transmission, and poetics.
